

# Rockpool Adaptations

## Pre activity - Rockpool for sale

### Objectives:

- To identify different characteristics of a Rockpool.
- To encourage children to write in full sentences using correct punctuation.
- To introduce the idea of persuasive writing.

### Activity description:

Pupils gather a variety of "property details" from a local estate agent. The details are studied and the children then write their own "property description" for a Rockpool habitat. The aim is to attract potential purchasers such as Mr. Crab (looking to downsize) or the ever growing Anemone family who need a bigger place to live.

## Post Activity - Rockpool play

### Objectives:

- Demonstrate awareness of the roles played by various Rockpool creatures.
- Show confidence within a group.
- Learn simple lines/ actions.

### Activity description:

Pupils act out a short play about the Rockpool creatures they have learnt about during their visit. Some can take the roll of animals they have studied and some could be the wind or the waves. The play could be developed to include moral values and shown to the rest of the school.
